

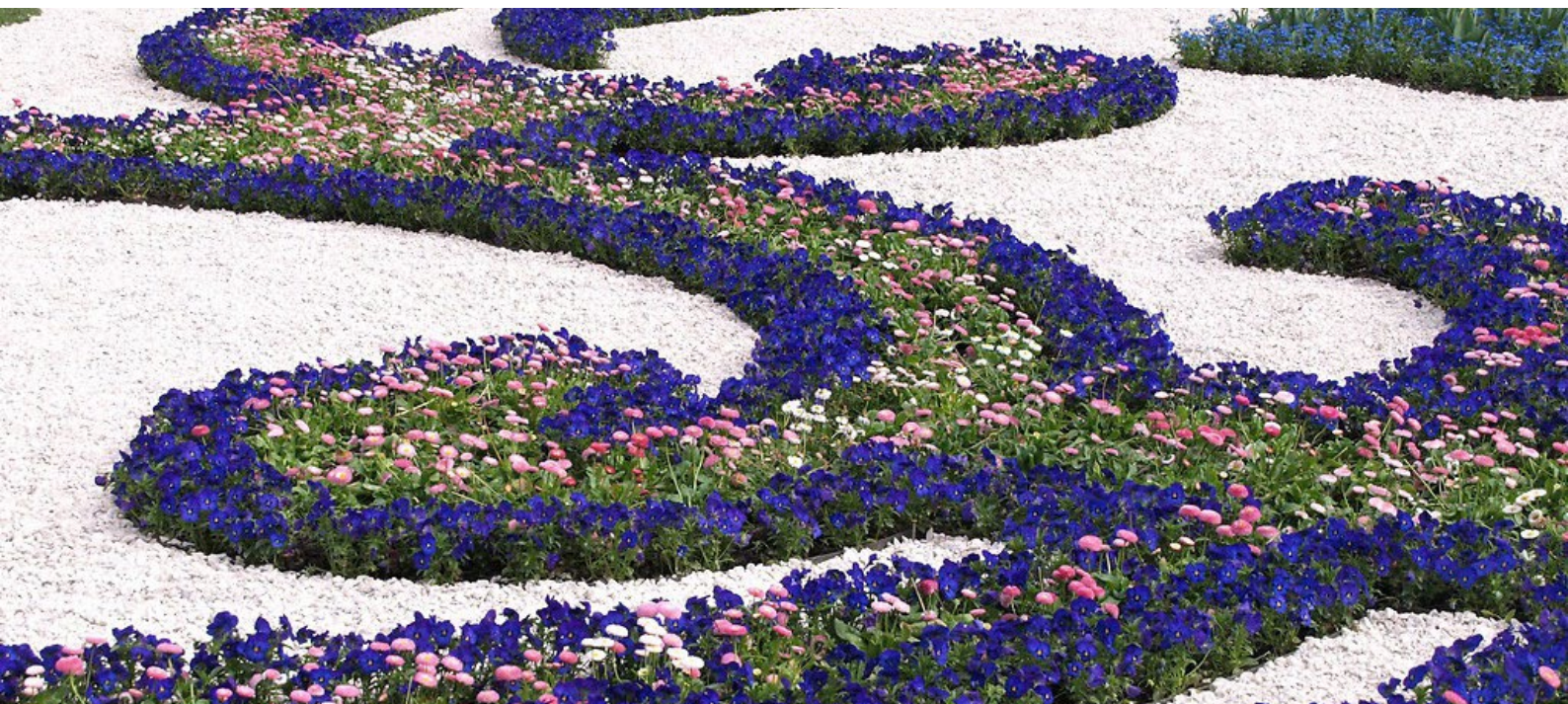

In October 2020, the European Route of Historic Gardens was certified by the Council of Europe. This was not only a great honour, but also an important step in recognising the historic, artistic, social and natural values of historic green spaces.

Admission to the Cultural Route of the Council of Europe has also opened up opportunities to participate in various projects promoting culture and tourism at the international level. What could be the role of the European Route of Historic Gardens in this regard? How can it be involved in the implementation of the European Union’s cultural policy?

The book presents a result of the thesis written by Jacek Kuśmierski, conservator of historic gardens and the ERHG independent collaborator, at the Postgraduate Studies “Cultural Diplomacy” at the Jagiellonian University, under the supervision of Prof. Bożena Gierat-Bieroń.

APRIL 26TH | VISIT WATER PATHS IN THE PARK OF MONSERRATE

Visit to the traditional water supply system from the springs to the fountains, waterfalls and lakes.

Water is the fundamental element par excellence in the landscape composition of Monserrate Park, as it is in all the existing properties in the Serra of Sintra. The water which supplies Monserrate Park is taken from inside the Tapada de Monserrate and also from the park itself by means of springs and water mines dug out of the granite, the geological material on which the Sintra Mountains have been shaped. The water is distributed from these mines through a complex Hydraulic System.

During the 20th century, the Tapada and Park of Monserrate properties were abandoned and the water systems were not kept in operation. The complex water system of the park has been the target of study and phased intervention since 2009, with the recovery and cleaning of the interior of springs and mines, channels, gutters and pipes.

Travelling back to the court of King Pedro III and Queen Maria I, this guided tour of the gardens of Queluz will show you the various spaces that were shaped according to 18th century Enlightenment thinking and were the royal family's place of recreation and enjoyment during the various events and anniversaries celebrated here.
